

Subject: Display of Site Map in Saved Site

SUMMARY

When IRIS Inquiry connects to a remote site a Site Map file is automatically retrieved from the site. This Site Map is saved in the local directory assigned to that site. These instructions give a method to view that Site Map in an offline mode.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

The Site Map in the saved site directory can be of many different file types JPG, PCX, IIF or others. The best way to view this Site Map file is as follows.

1. Using File Explorer, make a copy of the SiteMap.xxx file and copy it to the ProgramFiles/SecurityCenter/Inquiry\IRIS directory.
2. Change the extension on the file name to .IIF. Therefore, SiteMap.PCX should be changed to SiteMap.IIF.
3. Open Inquiry IRIS. Select File->Open. Select the SiteMap.IIF file.
4. You will get a dialog box indicating, "Transaction data file does not exist". That is normal for this file. Select OK.
5. Inquiry should open a window and display the image.

From here you can save the image to all of the file formats supported by Inquiry.
